

#### - Full day Tour of Obidos - Cabo Carvoeiro-Sanguinhal- Buddha Eden Park - Peniche

- Departure to Obidos and visit of this charming walled medieval village, with wonderful churches, libraries and a unique atmosphere. Entering the old city gate is stepping back in time. Stroll through its narrow streets among whitewashed, flower bedecked houses. Continuing to Caldas da Rainha, an artistic city, home to a school of fine arts and design and a vocational school for ceramics. The city centre has many excellent examples of Art Nouveau architecture, with beautifully tiled exteriors. You can take some of the art home with you, in the form of world-renowned ceramic creations from the Bordallo Pinheiro factory. In recognition of its crafts and folk art, UNESCO added Caldas to its Creative Cities Network in 2019.Continue to Quinta do Sanguinhal, a unique space with winery, presses and distillery from the 19th Century. It is a family company which explores 95ha of vineyards. Visit, wine tasting and lunch.
- Afterwards, departure to Buddha Eden Garden at Quinta dos Loridos-Europe's largest Asian garden and the continent's largest collection of Buddhist statues. They're scattered around 35 hectares (86 acres) of land, and were ordered by Portuguese businessman Joe Berardo in 2001. There's also an outstanding African Art Garden, showing over 200 carefully-placed works from different African countries hidden around the vegetation.
- Afterwards, travel towards Peniche, one of the largest traditional fishing ports in Portugal and a major Atlantic hub for maritime-tourist activities.
  Sightseeing visit of the town with the Peniche Fort, built in the 16th/17th centuries to defend the coast, it played a major role at



various points in Portuguese history but its most recent purpose was to serve as a political prison .Today is also well known for its beaches which are sought after by surfers and bodyboarders from across the world. It is the setting for the major world surf championship, Rip Curl Pro Portugal, an event that is part of the World Surf League Tour. Short stop for photos at Cape Carvoeiro, with curious geological formations that have been sculpted by the sea over time, this site offers spectacular views over the sea and the Berlenga islands, Nature Reserve and a natural sanctuary for sea flora and fauna. Return to the hotel.

#### - Full day Tour of Lisbon: Full day Lisboa:

Lisbon was the center of Europe's longest-lived overseas empire. Portugal's imperial ambitions date back to Prince Henry the Navigator's 15th-century discoveries in West Africa. Morning sightseeing featuring a drive to Belem Quarter with ist most important monuments such as Jerónimos Monastery, a splendid example of Portuguese Gothic style known as Manueline. Stop also at the Belem Tower guarding the mouth of the Tejo river, and the Monument to the Discoveries. Then, heading to Lisbon downtown, The Baixa guarter, it was completely rebuilt after the Great Earthquake of 1755, with streets flanked by uniform, neoclassical buildings. This was Europe's first great example of neoclassical design and urban planning, and one of the finest European architectural achievements of the age (it's currently being considered to be listed as a World Heritage Site). Stop at Rossio Square and free time for shopping or lunch (not included). After lunch enjoy a walk through the ancient Alfama district built by the Moors in their typical winding, narrow street pattern. Is also the birthplace of the Fado music, which has been declared a World Heritage. Afterwards return to the hotel.

- Departure to Alcobaça ,and visit of its Monastery of Santa Maria ,one of the magnificent buildings of the 12th century. It is a masterpiece of early Gothic style in Portugal. It is in this monastery that King Pedro and his lover Inês, called as Portuguese "Romeo and Juliet", are buried. The story of eternal love, sad and tragic story, that captures with its drama was glorified by poets, artists, writers and never left anybody indifferent.
- Continue to Nazare, a colorful fishing village home to the biggest surfable waves in the world!. This is one beach in Portugal where the old fishing customs are extremely colorful, and you will often come across women wearing seven skirts in keeping with tradition. Lunch at Restaurant S.
  Miguel or similar.
- After lunch, the journey continues to Batalha with visit of he Dominican Abbey of Santa Maria da Vitoria, which is a true masterpiece of late Gothic style, with elements of pure Portuguese Manueline style. This monastery became a symbol of the grandeur of the monarchy and the pantheon of the most famous dynasty of Portuguese Kings, the Avis. Batalha monastery of Santa Maria da Vitoria is recognized by UNESCO as a monument of the world heritage.
- Drive to the nearby town of Fatima which is one of the main shrines in the Christian world, a place of pilgrimage for millions of people from all over the world. Visit to the world famous Our Lady of Fatima Sanctuary. Return to the hotel.

- Departure to World Heritage-listed Sintra village, situated in beautiful wooded mountains to thw west of Lisbon. Long ago a summer retreat for royalty and the wealthy, the city today is a charming collection of 19th century chalets, villas and trendy shops. Visit of the medieval Palace, the summer residence of Portuguese kings and queens and an excellent display of the famous Portuguese glazed tiles known as "azuleijos".
- Continue to the westernmost point of continental Europe at Roca Cape and enjoy the stunning views. Short stop for photos. Travelling along the coast on the way to Cascais, a pretty fishing town, once a royal family and aristocracy summer town, which combines grand 19th century architecture with traditional Portuguese charm. Cascais's history as a cosmopolitan center originates in the late 19th century, when King Luís I and the Portuguese royal family made from this seaside town their summer residence. During World War II and the Post-War period, the area's royal affiliations intensified, as many heads of European royal houses and deposed monarchs, made their home in Cascais and Estoril, finding refuge in Portugal's neutrality. Lunch at the Marina Restaurant "Marisco na Praça".
- After lunch enjoy the panoramic views of Estoril, a stylish beach resort with its sandy beaches and glitzy casino. Starting to develop early 20th. Century, Estoril gained a key role as international tourist spot right from the beginning. With one of the biggest and oldest Casinos in Europe, it attracted royalty, businessman and intelligence services during the neutrality of Portugal in World War II with reference to the presence of lan Flemming who later wrote the novels of James Bond. Return to the hotel.


